# Save the Date: APRIL 17 IN-PERSON MEETING

Nose Breathing, Sleep Apnea, and the Primary Care Dentist



This talk will show how dentists can become more important in their patient's health care team by asking the right questions, looking for more ways to help, and providing people with a car-

ing, friendly health care provider who is interested in prevention. At the end of this talk, learners will: be able to ask the right questions during a health history to uncover important medical data; guide patients to understand the connection between nose breathing and general health; and see themselves not as 'only a dentist' but as an integral part of primary health care.

Steve Carstensen DDS has treated sleep apnea and snoring in Bellevue since 1998. He's the Consultant to the ADA for sleep related breathing disorders and heads the ADA's Children's Airway Initiative. He lectures internationally, directs sleep education at Airway Technologies and the Pankey Institute and is a guest lecturer at Spear Education and Louisiana State Dental School, in addition to advising several other sleep-related manufacturers. The American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine awarded him with the Distinguished Service Award in 2023.


