# Save the Date: VIRTUAL Member Meeting, Wed. November 15

Intimate Partner Violence Post COVID Lockdown & the Role of Dentistry



Our presenter is Dr. Barbara J. Steinberg. Her class looks at how in the COVID-era, marital, partner and familial stressors have gone from normal tensions to intimate partner violence (IPV).

The stay-at-home restrictions increased these incidents of IPV. IPV can happen to anyone, affecting people across all socioeconomic groups. It has been shown that physical trauma to the orofacial, head and neck region is very common among victims of IPV. In light of this, members of the dental team are in a position to help identify these patients and refer them for help. This course will discuss all aspects of IPV and offer communication techniques for members of the dental team to help identify these victims and refer them to local resources for desperately needed help - perhaps even saving their lives! Members of the dental team will learn:

- The incidence, risk factors and manifestations of IPV
- Identify oro-facial, head and neck findings caused by physical abuse
- Communication techniques to approach patients with suspected trauma secondary to IPV.

Dr. Steinberg received her DDS from the University of Maryland School of Dentistry. She is Clinical Professor of Surgery at Drexel University College of Medicine, as well as Adjunct Associate Professor of Oral Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine.
